

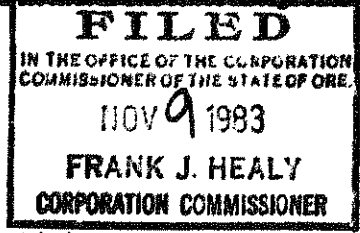

The procedure for the formation of nonprofit corporations is set forth in ORS 61.304 through 61.309. See ORS 61.311 for the content of Articles of Incorporation.

Articles of Incorporation

The undersigned natural person(s) of the age of eighteen years or more, a domestic or foreign corporation, a partnership or an association acting as incorporators under the Oregon Nonprofit Corporation Law, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I The name of this corporation is Society for the Study of Chronic Illness, Impairment and Disability

(The corporate Name cannot contain any word or phrase which indicates or implies that it is organized for any purpose other than one or more of the purposes contained in its articles of incorporation; and cannot contain the word "cooperative". See ORS 61.071.)

and its duration shall be perpetual

ARTICLE II The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
The Society for the Study of Chronic Illness, Impairment and Disability is founded for the purpose of promoting the development of social scientific knowledge concerning chronically ill, impaired and disabled persons in society. SSCIID is founded with the additional purposes of creating forums in which social scientific researchers can present their research findings and for other educational, research and scientific purposes.

(It is not necessary to set forth in the articles any of the corporate powers enumerated in ORS 61.061. It is sufficient to state, either alone or with other purposes, "That the corporation may engage in any lawful activity, none of which is for profit, for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 61"; however, it is desirable to state the primary purpose of the corporation in conjunction with such statement.)

ARTICLE III The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is Department of Sociology, Willamette University, 900 State Street, Salem, Oregon 97301

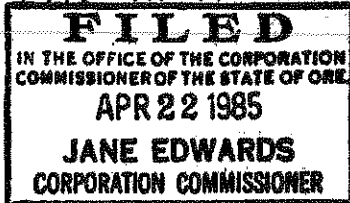

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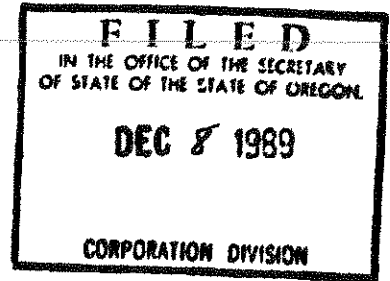
